## The Daily What? The Practice of Ordered Prayer

‘How do Anglicans pray?’ Father Zosima in Dostoevsky’s novel *The Brothers Karamazov* says “Prayer is an education.”

We invite you to learn the Anglican way of prayer but our greater hope and desire is for this series to enrich your life with God and each other, as you learn to pray after the pattern of our Church since its beginning: *The Daily What? The Anglican Practice of Ordered Prayer*.

Beginning the week of Sunday of Feb. 17th continuing through the week of Sunday April 8th you can come either to the Sunday evening slot of 4:00-6:00pm, or to the Monday evening slot of 7:00-9:00pm You will learn about the *Daily Office*, which is the historic Anglican practice of ordered prayer.
